Norfolk Island Victualling List 1802

This listing was published in Musters and Lists New South Wales and Norfolk Island 1800-1802. Edited by Carol J. Baxter. Pub. by ABGR, Sydney. 1988.

This volume records the rations issued to Norfolk Island residents in the year 1802. It contains the following information:

- 1. Reference Number: Allocated to each entry to serve as a link with the index and appendices.
- 2. Category: Describes the status of the subject, namely whether the subject is a member of the civil or military department, a free arrival, a convict or ex-convict or a child.
- 3. Time of Victualling: Records the date at which victualling commenced for the subject within the year 1802.
- 4. Name: Records the name of the person being victualled. Abbreviated given names have been extended to their full form.
- **5. Quality:** Records the rank or occupation of the subject.
- 6. Time When Off Victualling: Records the reason for which the subject is no longer victualled (Departed, Deceased, etc.) and the date at which victualling ceased.
- **7. Days Victualled:** Records the total number of days victualled for the year.
