## Deaths in Sydney Hospital NSW 1811-1812, 1818 & 1826

In the early decades of the New South Wales colony clergy and magistrates recorded births, marriages and deaths. Clergymen kept church registers and sent duplicate lists known as civil returns to the Colonial Secretary's Office. In more remote areas with no clergyman, or in civil institutions such as Sydney Hospital, magistrates and other officials recorded births and deaths and sent returns to the Colonial Secretary's Office which have survived in various formats. In certain circumstances magistrates could also celebrate civil marriages.

This dataset is a partial transcript of miscellaneous civil returns of deaths in Sydney Hospital and elsewhere during 1811-1812, 1818 & 1826 held in Colonial Secretary Special Bundles files at State Archives New South Wales.
